NOTICE OF DETERMINATION, ORDER FOR SUPERVISION AND CONSENT TO ORDER

Respondent.

It appears and it is the opinion of the Director of Insurance that the condition of Respondent AMERICAN PATHFINDERS, INC. is such as to render the continuance of its business hazardous to the public or to holders of its policies or certificates of insurance, for the following reasons, without limitation:

- 1. Respondent AMERICAN PATHFINDERS, INC.
 ["PATHFINDERS"] is an Arizona corporation licensed as a full
 lines property and casualty agent in this State.
- 2. Since on or about January 22, 1988, PATHFINDERS has been authorized by OLD HICKORY CASUALTY INSURANCE COMPANY ["OLD HICKORY"], a Louisiana corporation authorized to transact insurance in the State of Arizona, as an independent contractor to exercise general supervision over OLD HICKORY's business in this state.
- 3. At all material times, one Kevin Allen did act as an officer and/or manager of PATHFINDERS and had responsibilities including the processing, adjustment, and payment of claims of OLD HICKORY policyholders.
- 4. On or about May 31, 1990, the Director suspended the insurance license of Kevin Allen based upon his alleged

involvement with false claims and payments under PATHFINDERS's auto policies.

5. The present condition of PATHFINDERS is such as to render its business hazardous to the public, policyholders, and/or OLD HICKORY within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-169.

THEREFORE, the Director now makes the determination to supervise PATHFINDERS, and hereby notifies PATHFINDERS that it is under the supervision of the Department of Insurance and that the Director is applying and effecting the provisions of Chapter 1, Article 2, A.R.S. Title 20.

- A. The requirements to abate this Order upon completion of the current and ongoing market conduct examination of OLD HICKORY are that PATHFINDERS shall:
- (1) Establish and maintain policies and procedures satisfactory to the Director to assure the appropriate and timely processing and payment of claims and service to the accounts of policyholders pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, Title 20;
- (2) Establish and maintain appropriate supervisory and personnel policies satisfactory to the Director to ensure the adequate levels and expertise of PATHFINDERS's staff;
- (3) Maintain and secure, where necessary, appropriate personnel satisfactory to the Director to conduct the business of the agency;
- (4) Establish an auditable system of records and accounts satisfactory to the Director so as to assure the proper collection and disbursement of funds;

- (5) Maintain and/or obtain all appropriate licenses for the transaction of the agency's business.
- B. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, §20-170, the Director may appoint a Supervisor over the business of PATHFINDERS to effectuate the provisions of this Order.
- C. Pursuant to A.R.S. §20-170, PATHFINDERS, during the period of supervision, may not do any of the following things without prior approval of the Director or her supervisor:
 - (1) Dispose of, convey or encumber any of its assets or any other entity's assets of over which PATHFINDERS may have control;
 - (2) Make withdrawal from any of its bank accounts;
 - (3) Lend any of its funds;
 - (4) Invest any of its funds;
 - (5) Transfer any of its property;
 - (6) Incur any debts, obligations or liabilities, whether insurance related or otherwise; or
 - (7) Merge or consolidate with another company.
- D. Pursuant to A.R.S. §20-171(C), the costs incident to the services of the Director, or her supervisor or conservator, or any or all of them shall be charged against the assets and funds of OLD HICKORY and shall be paid when fixed and determined by the Director.
- E. The Order Appointing a Supervisor shall in no way limit the Director's authority to commence delinquency proceedings in the Superior Court or to take any other appropriate and lawful action at any time during the period of supervision or anytime thereafter.

F. Because good cause exists therefor, this Notice and Order shall become effective immediately.
