On or about January 12, 1995, the Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance (Director) commenced an investigation of Respondents Arizona Sunburst Kachina Underwriting Services, Inc., dba Insurance World, (currently licensed as a property and casualty insurance broker and a property and casualty insurance agent, license No. 512067, which license expires March 31, 1996) and Unigroup Insurance Corporation, (currently licensed as a property and casualty insurance broker, license No. 17822, which license expires March 31, 1996) (Respondents) pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-142(C). The investigation revealed Respondents' violations of Arizona Revised Statutes, Title 20. On April 5, 1995, Morgan individually and on behalf of Respondents, entered a Consent Order in docket no. 95-067 to resolve that matter without commencement of formal proceedings. The April 5, 1995, Consent Order contains admissions to Findings of Facts and consent to the entry of Conclusions of Law and an Order revoking Morgan's individual property and casualty insurance broker licenses.

On or about April 4, 1995 all of Respondents assets were purchased by a third party. No insurance business continues to exist under Respondents' licenses and no employees or licensed

agents are transacting insurance business under Respondents' licenses.

Respondents now desire to resolve any outstanding issues arising out of the above referenced investigation without commencement of formal proceedings and hereby consent to the entry of the following Order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that the licenses of Arizona Sunburst Kachina Underwriting Services, Inc., Insurance World and of Unigroup Insurance Corporation are immediately revoked upon entry of this Order.

Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Order by the Director of Insurance, State of Arizona, is solely for the purpose of settling this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency or officer of this state or subdivision thereof from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.
- 6. Robert Chrysler Morgan represents that he is the Chief Executive Officer and President of Respondent Unigroup, and that as such he has been duly authorized to enter into this Order on its behalf.
- 7. Robert Chrysler Morgan represents that he is the Chief Executive Officer of Respondent Insurance World, and that as such he has been duly authorized to enter into this Order on its behalf.
