FINDINGS OF FACT

- Respondent is a California corporation, and a wholly owned subsidiary of Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, licensed to transact property and casualty, including workers' compensation, insurance in the State of California.
- On October 3, 1997, Respondent submitted an application the Arizona Department of Insurance for a certificate of authority to transact casualty with workers' compensation, among other lines of insurance, in the State of Arizona.
- 3. As of. October 28, 1997, Respondent the has met requirements for the issuance of the certificate of authority, in accordance with A.R.S. Title 20.
- Prior to October 28, 1997 Respondent issued seventy-seven insurance policies in this state without possessing a certificate of authority therefor, as identified in exhibits A and B hereto.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent has violated A.R.S. §§ 20-107, 20-206 and 1. 20-401.01.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Respondent shall pay a civil money penalty in the amount of \$10,000, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-220.
- 2. Immediately after issuance of the certificate of authority to Respondent, as ordered in paragraph 7 below, Respondent shall issue replacement policies, retroeffective to the date of original issuance by Respondent, for each policy identified on exhibit A and for every other workers' compensation policy which may be subsequently discovered to have been issued in this State by Respondent prior to October 28, 1997.
- 3. Liberty Mutual Insurance Company shall issue a Reinsurance Cut Through Endorsement, in the form attached as exhibit C hereto, with respect to each of the policies identified in exhibits A and B and any additional policies identified in paragraph 2 above.
- 4. The rates and forms ultimately approved by the Arizona Department of Insurance for initial use by Respondent in Arizona shall be deemed the effective rates and forms with respect to the policies identified in exhibits A and B and any additional policies identified in paragraph 2 above, for all purposes, to the extent such policies are not exempt from the requirement of approved rates and forms.
- 5. Respondent shall include the premium received in consideration for the policies identified in exhibits A and B and any additional policies identified in paragraph 2 above on its tax reports for the applicable period and shall pay the premium tax due relative to such premiums, as if Respondent had been author-

ized to issue such policies, in accordance with A.R.S. §§ 20-224, 23-961 and 23-1065.

- 6. Respondent shall establish a special deposit for the protection of affected policyholders and claimants under the policies identified in exhibits A and B and any additional policies identified in paragraph 2 in the amount of \$1,200,000 (One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars) in the form attached as exhibit D hereto.
- 7. Respondent shall be issued a certificate of authority to transact insurance in this state as applied for, with an effective date of October 28, 1997.







REINSURANCE CUT-THROUGH ENDORSEMENT

(hereinafter referred to as the "Endorsement")

This Endorsement is made by and between GOLDEN EAGLE INSURANCE CORPORATION, a California domiciled insurer with its principal office in San Diego, California (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") and LIBERTY MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY, a Massachusetts domiciled insurer with Administrative Offices in Boston, Massachusetts (hereinafter referred to as the "Reinsurer").

For value received, the Reinsurer and the Company hereby agree that, with respect to loss payment obligations arising under the Company's policy identified below (hereinafter referred to as the "Policy"), which Policy is reinsured in whole or in part by the Reinsurer.

- 1. In the event the Company is declared insolvent and placed in liquidation by a court of competent jurisdiction, and therefore is unable to pay any loss for which the Company would be legally liable under the Policy, the Reinsurer shall become liable to pay the reinsurance liability for the loss directly to the Insured.
- 2. The Reinsurer's obligation to make loss payments pursuant to this Endorsement shall be limited as they appear in the Policy, by the Company's liability under the terms, limits and conditions contained in the Policy; by the Reinsurer's liability; and by applicable state law.
- 3. Any payment by the Reinsurer pursuant to this Endorsement shall be, to the extent of the payment, in substitution, satisfaction and discharge of the reinsurance obligation to the Company. Neither this Endorsement, nor any other agreement, shall be construed in a manner which would subject the Reinsurer to liability for a duplicative payment of losses reinsured.
- 4. This Endorsement shall expire upon the earlier of the renewal or the cancellation of the Policy listed below.
- 5. The provisions of this Endorsement shall apply only with respect to losses covered under the Policy listed below.

SECURITY DEPOSIT , ASSIGNMENT, AND TRUST AGREEMENT FOR SOLE BENEFIT OF ARIZONA POLICYHOLDERS AND CLAIMANTS

This agreement is made, by and between Golden Eagle Insurance Corporation, a California corporation, with its principal place of business at San Diego, CA, hereinafter referred to as "Insurer", the Arizona Department of Insurance, hereinafter "Department" and the Arizona State Treasurer.

The Insurer has been, is or will be engaged in the transaction of insurance within the State of Arizona and has and/or will issue insurance policies to Arizona residents. In order to provide additional security to all Arizona residents that purchased insurance policies from the Insurer which became effective prior to October 28, 1997, hereinafter "The Policies", and claimants under such policies, the Insurer hereby deposits and assigns to the Arizona State Treasurer, as Trustee, the following described property for the benefit of all Arizona policyholders within and claimants under The Policies as follows:

The following securities or like kind held by BNY Western Trust Company in a segregated account maintained in Trust for the Arizona State Treasurer for statutory and other special deposits as may be required:

The assets of the Insurer which are the subject of this agreement are intended to be security for Arizona residents who are policyholders within The Policies or claimants against such policyholders only and it is the intent of the parties that a claim of an Arizona resident within The Policies or a claimant thereof be a "secured claim" within the meaning of A. R. S. §20-611(11) and that the deposited and assigned assets are being placed in trust with the Arizona State Treasurer to act as a security deposit for the sole benefit of the Arizona residents within The Policies and all claimants against members of The Policies. The Insurer consents and agrees that in the event of the insolvency of he Insurer the above deposited, assigned and trusteed assets shall be considered "security" within the meaning of A. R. S. §20-629(E) and that the Arizona policyholders within The Policies and claimants thereof shall be deemed "secured" claimants within the meaning of A. R. S. §20-629(E). The parties specifically agree that no part of the assets which are subject to this agreement shall be deemed to be a "Statutory" deposit within the meaning of A. R. S. §20-213 even though such assets may be held and commingled with assets held for Statutory deposit purposes within the account established for such purposes with BNY Western Trust Company, its successors, or such other bank or trust company which shall be acceptable to the Arizona State Treasurer. The Insurer expressly recognizes that its "Statutory" Deposit requirement under A. R. S. §20-213 must be other wise satisfied.

The Insurer warrants that it has free and clear title to the assets which are the subject of this agreement, and that the assets are not subject to or restricted by any encumbrance, lien, pledge, assignment, trust or any other kind of claim or interest.

The Insurer further warrants that the amount of this Special Deposit is at least equal to the sum of the unearned premium and loss and loss adjustment expense gross reserve, herein defined as direct loss and loss adjustment expense without application of reinsurance, related to Arizona policyholders within and claimants under The Policies together with an additional 10% of such sum to account for market value fluctuation.

This assignment and expressed trust deposit for the benefit of Arizona policyholders within The Policies and claimants thereof is irrevocable and shall be maintained so long as The Policies are in force or all claims associated with such policies are settled or otherwise liquidated whichever is later, provided however, that the Department and the Arizona State Treasurer hereby agree that the assets deposited in connection with this Agreement shall be released as special deposits and shall, upon application by the Insurer, convert to "Statutory" Deposits within the meaning of A. R. S. §20-213 as the premiums represented by The Policies are earned and losses paid, provided further that such releases do not reduce the remaining deposit to an amount less than the sum of the unearned premium and loss and loss adjustment expense gross reserves related to Arizona policyholders within The Policies together with an additional 10% of such sum to account for market value fluctuation.
