ORDER

On May 31, 1995 and September 29, 1995, a hearing took place in the above-referenced matter. Assistant Attorney General W. 

Dear Mark:

This is to confirm the "settlement agreement" that was reached between my client and the Arizona Department of Insurance. My client has agreed to accomplish the following things:

1. Pay a late fee of \$68.25.
2. Resubmit a new NAIC Biographical Affidavit for Gladys Vasquez on Insurance Department form E110.R&R (Rev. 08/95).
3. Submit a certification of the financial statement including a statement regarding Arizona self insureds.

All of these items will be accomplished on or before the close of business on Wednesday, October 4, 1995. If they are not accomplished before that time and date, then the Insurance Department will revoke my client's license.

In addition, if my client wishes to submit a renewal application for 1996 the complete application must be at the Insurance Department on or before November 1, 1995. If my client's complete application is not at the Insurance Department by then, then my client agrees that it's license may be revoked.

In connection with the revocation of my client's license (either because it fails to comply with the three stipulations by October 4, 1995 or it does not submit a renewal application on or before November 1, 1995), then my client waives the Notice of Hearing and a right to hearing and any other rights it may be entitled to under the Arizona Insurance Code or the Administrative Procedures Act.
